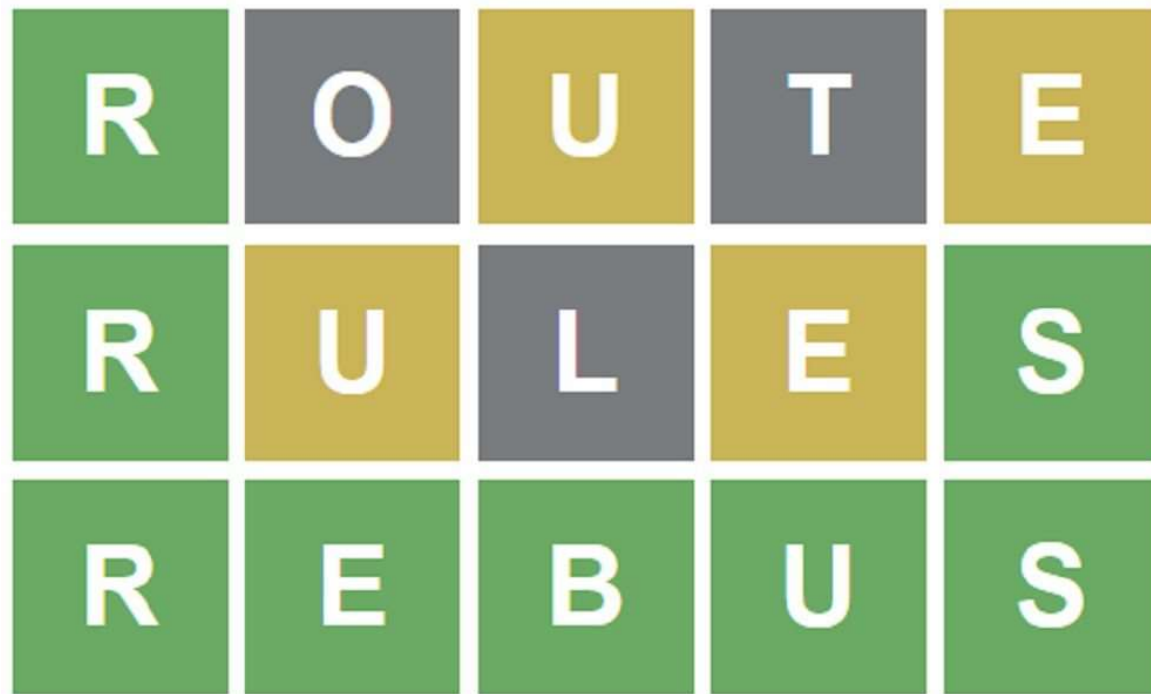

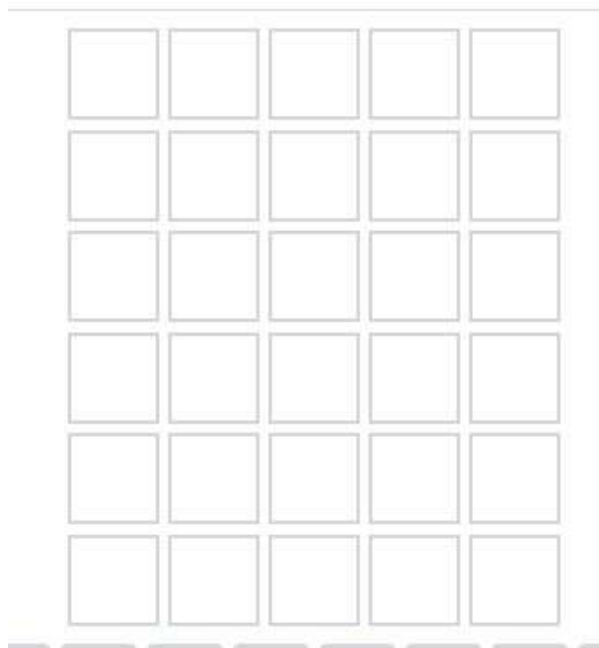

- ▶ Day of the Dead originated several thousand years ago with the Aztec, **Toltec**, and other Nahua people, who considered **mourning** the dead disrespectful. For these pre-Hispanic cultures, death was a natural phase in life's long **continuum**. The dead were still members of the community, kept alive in **memory** and spirit—and during Día de los Muertos, they temporarily returned to Earth. Today's Día de los Muertos celebration is a **mash-up** of pre-Hispanic religious rites and Christian **feasts**. It takes place on November 1 and 2—All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day on the Catholic calendar—around the time of the fall maize harvest.
- ▶ Canadian Thanksgiving kicked off with a feast of biscuits, salt beef, and **mushy peas** in 1578. That's when Sir Martin Frobisher sailed from England in search of the **Northwest Passage**. After his crew's arrival in Canada's most northerly territory Frobisher's men gathered, ate, and took part in a **Church of England** service with an **Anglican minister** who preached a **godly sermon**. Canadian Thanksgiving is observed on the second Monday of October every year, though many opt to feast on the weekend. Its date has moved around several times, but in 1957, the government settled on October. It's an official **statutory holiday** throughout Canada except in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. Employers aren't required to pay their employees for the day off, so families often celebrate it the day before.

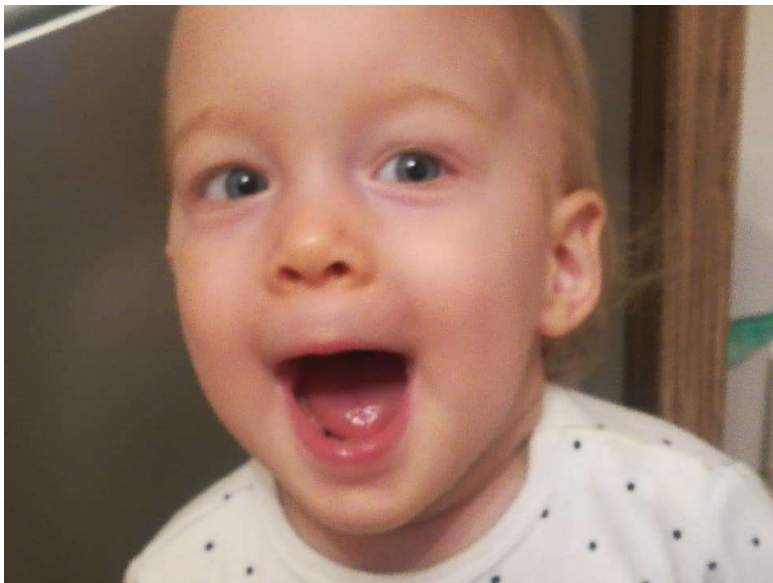
